Introduction

Hypatia Analytics, LLC (“Hypatia Analytics”, “we”, “our”, “us”) operates hypatia-analytics.com (the “Site”) as an informational website for reading and knowledge sharing. This Privacy Policy explains what limited information we collect when you visit the Site and how we use it. There is no account registration, purchase, or other interactive feature on the Site beyond browsing its content and contacting us by email.

By using the Site, you agree to this Privacy Policy. If you disagree with it, please do not use the Site.

Information we collect

Information you provide

The Site does not require registration and has no user accounts. If you choose to contact us using the email address provided on the Site, we will receive your email address, name (if you provide it), and the contents of your message. We use this information only to respond to you and do not add you to any mailing list without your separate consent.

Information collected automatically

Like most websites, we automatically collect certain technical information when you visit the Site (“Usage Data”), using cookies and similar technologies. This includes your IP address, approximate location based on IP address, device and browser type, pages viewed, referring site, and date and time stamps. We use Google Analytics to understand overall traffic and how visitors use the Site — for example, which pages are most read.

We do not use this information to identify you personally, and we do not combine it with any account, since the Site has none.

How we use this information

- Responding to emails or inquiries you send us.
- Understanding how the Site is used and improving its content and performance.
- Maintaining the security of the Site.
- Complying with applicable legal obligations.

We do not use artificial intelligence to process visitor information, and we do not sell personal information for monetary consideration.

Cookies

The Site uses cookies from Google Analytics to measure traffic and usage. Google processes this information under its own privacy policy. You can opt out of Google Analytics tracking by installing the Google Analytics Opt-out Browser Add-on, or by adjusting your cookie preferences or browser settings.

Disabling cookies may affect how some parts of the Site display, but will not prevent you from reading its content.

Data sharing

We do not sell your personal information. We share limited Usage Data with Google Analytics, as described above, to help us understand Site traffic. We may also disclose information where required to comply with applicable law, a court order, or a governmental authority, or to protect our rights or the rights of others.

Data retention

We keep emails you send us only as long as needed to respond to and, if relevant, maintain a record of the inquiry. Usage Data collected through Google Analytics is retained according to our Google Analytics account settings, consistent with Google's data retention practices.

Data security

We take reasonable measures designed to protect the limited information we collect. However, no method of transmission over the internet is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee absolute security.

Data breach notification

If we become aware of a security incident affecting personal information you have provided to us (for example, through an email inquiry), we will notify affected individuals and, where required, relevant regulators without undue delay and in accordance with applicable law.

Your privacy rights

Depending on where you live, you may have rights under laws such as the EU/UK General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), the California Consumer Privacy Act as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act (CCPA/CPRA), the Maryland Online Data Privacy Act (MODPA), and other U.S. state privacy laws. Because the Site collects very little personal information, these rights will typically relate only to an email you have sent us or to Usage Data. Subject to applicable law, you have the right to access, correct, or delete personal information we hold about you, to opt out of any sale or sharing of personal information (we engage in neither), and to not be discriminated against for exercising these rights.
